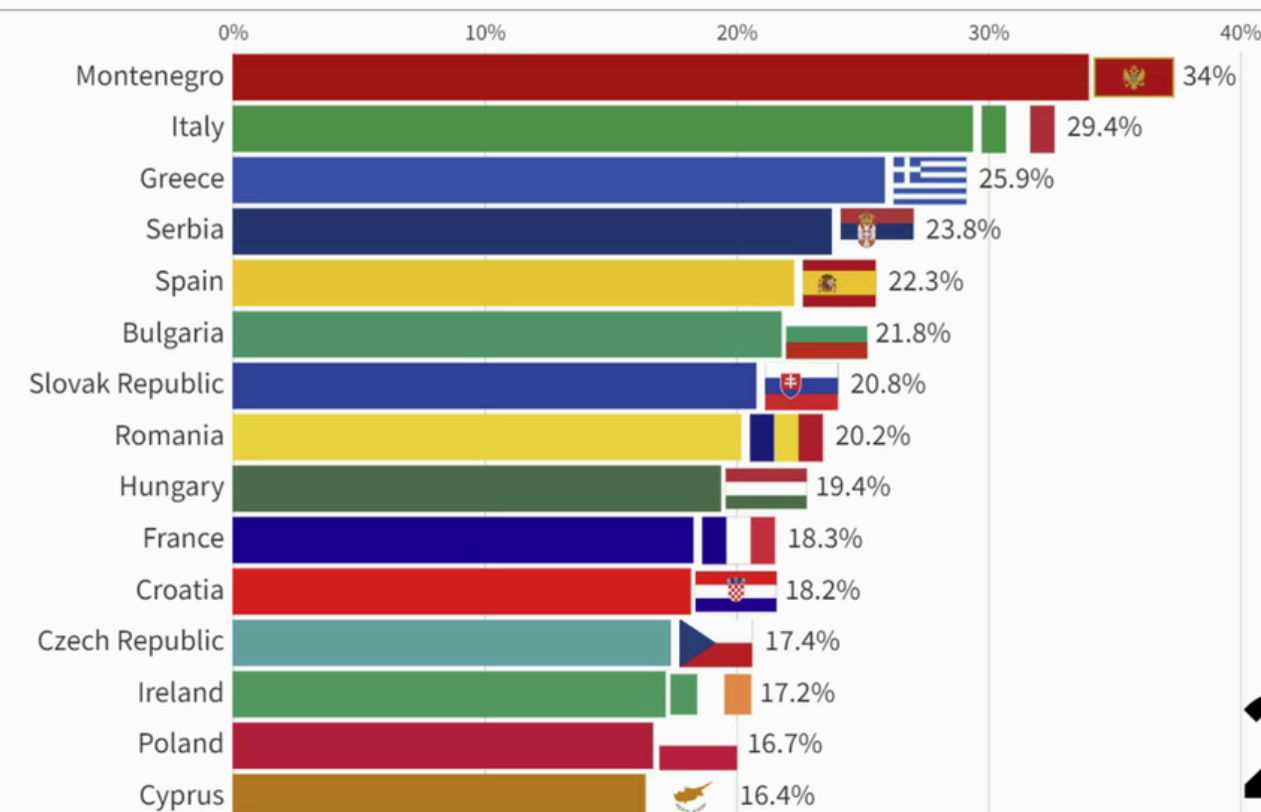
Project description



Reasoning Behind the Project

In today's rapidly changing job market, young people are experiencing greater job mobility and longer transition periods before securing stable employment. This shift makes it essential to ensure a smooth **transition from education** to the workforce while addressing the risks associated with **being neither in employment, education, nor training (NEET)**. Prolonged disengagement from both education and the labor market can have significant negative consequences—not only for the individuals affected but also for society as a whole. By tackling these challenges proactively, we can equip young people with the skills and confidence needed to navigate the job market successfully.

This is going to be activities venue and our accommodation.

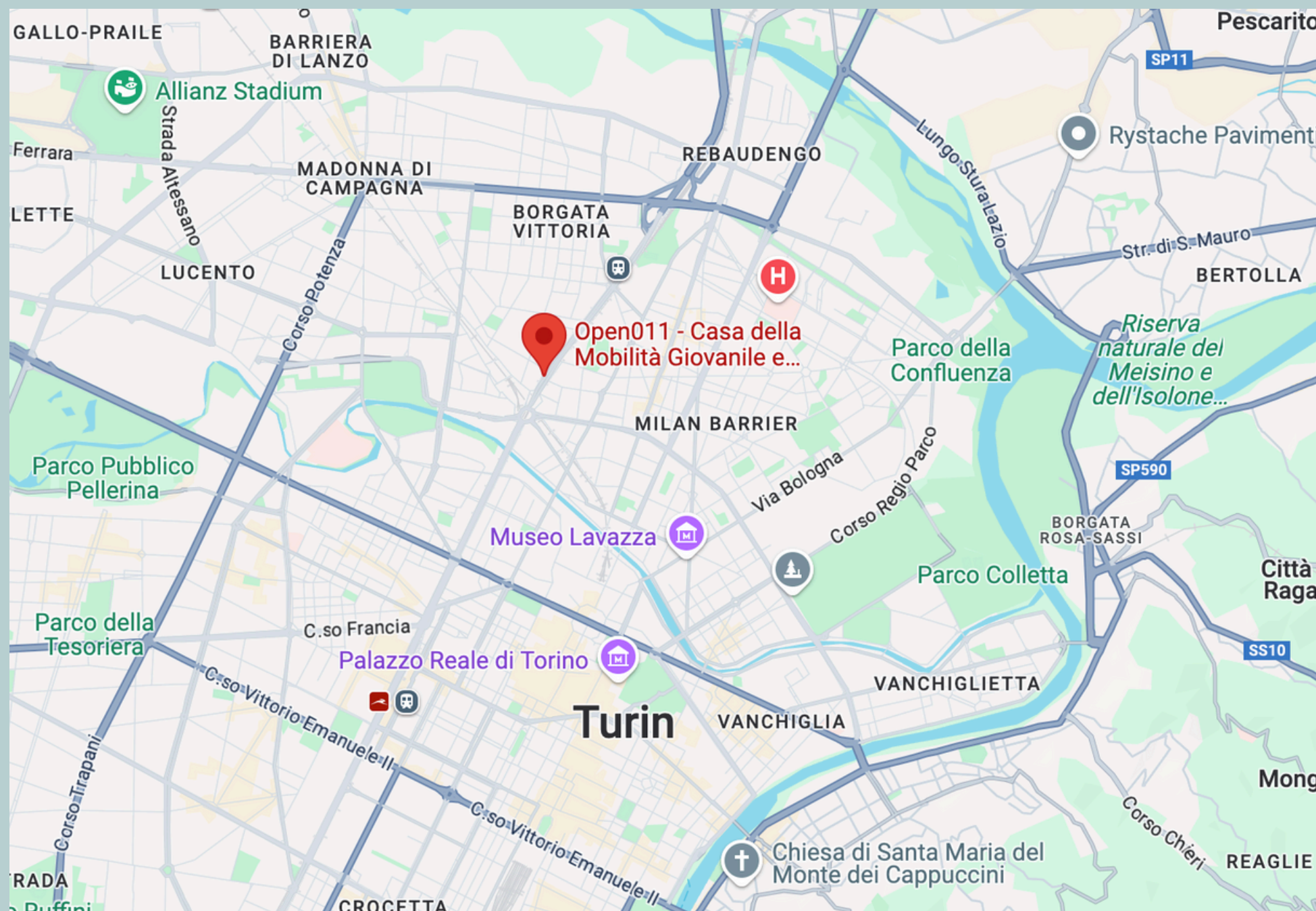
- Most of the activities will take place in the venue meeting rooms and some in other areas of the city.

However, if they are not currently engaged in these organizations, we welcome those with a strong interest in education, social inclusion, and youth employability.
- The perfect participants will be **dynamic, proactive**, and willing to share their experiences and ideas, contributing to a collaborative and impactful project.

Travel, accommodation and food costs are fully funded by the Erasmus+ program.

Travel costs are reimbursed within the **maximum reimbursement amounts** listed on the right. Participants will receive the **travel reimbursement via bank transfer within 2 months after the end of the project.**

To be entitled to full project reimbursement I confirm that:

- I send **original and scanned copies of their travel documentation**, flight receipts indicating prices, and **boarding passes** of each flight taken (send us **the screenshots before leaving!**)
- I don't arrive later than the time mentioned in the infopack:
- I do not depart before the time mentioned in the infopack:
- I can obtain the **cheapest tickets** (3rd 2nd/basic class tickets);
- I have to book my main tickets (flight/train/bus) both ways before the set deadline;
- I can arrive/leave **within the total of 2 days** from the arrival/departure day;
- If you come before the 22nd of June or stay after the 30th of June, hotel and food costs to and transportation from the airport will be on your charge.
- I have to choose the **most direct route** from your city of residence to the project venue;
- Before I buy tickets I wait for the **approval of the organizers.**
