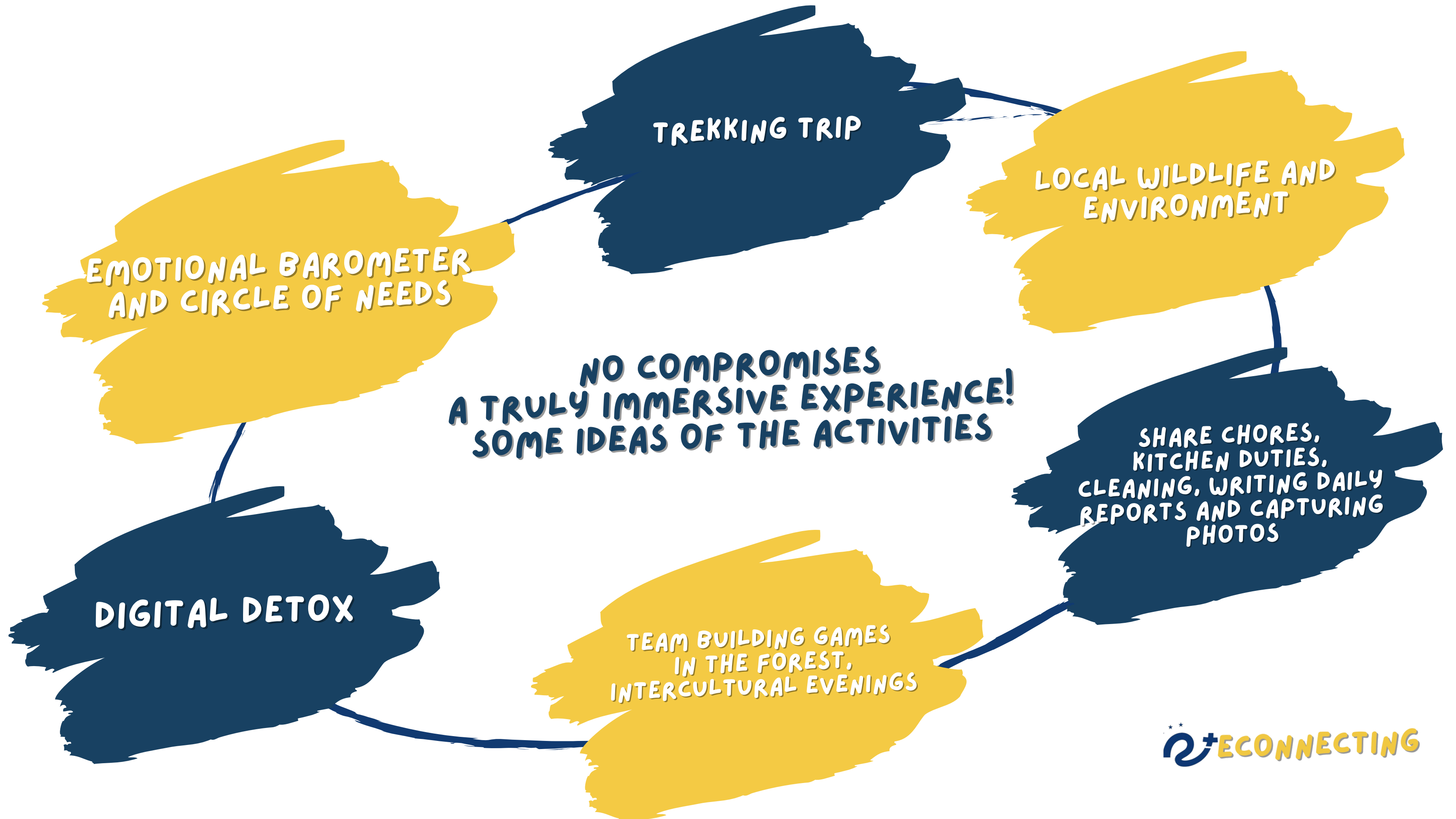
THE MAIN GOAL OF THE PROJECT

EXPLORING: WHAT?

Our goal is to plant seeds of hope by **strengthening our connection to the natural world** and rethinking **the way we live and interact with it**. Together, we will question existing perspectives, share personal insights, and co-create **practical tools** to **promote sustainability** and **active citizenship**

CHANGING: HOW?

Through the experience of **community living, meaningful group activities and time for personal reflection and connection**. This will take place in a **inspiring environment** located on Mount Badone, a mountain in in Northern Italy



THE LOCATION



THE ASSOCIATION

The **social promotion association Noi San Carlo** was founded by a **group of young people** from the parish of San Carlo in southern Trento to foster a sense of community. Together, they organize **youth groups, catechism, parish events, and summer camps** in Deggia, collaborating with other parish and neighborhood groups.

THE HOUSE

Surrounded by pine, beech, and spruce woods, the Deggia house includes **two floors for sleeping and hygiene, and a third with a kitchen and dining hall**. Sports fields and a large tent allow for varied activities. Nearby, the village of San Lorenzo offers **essential services like a bakery and a Coop supermarket**

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

ARRIVAL

The meeting point is **by 5 PM on August 30th in Trento**, near the train station (Lungadige Monte Grappa, 1, 38121 Trento TN). There, you'll meet a member of our team and **a bus** we've booked **will take all of us to the house**.

DEPARTURE

Check-out will be at **10 AM on September 6th**. **A bus** will take you back to the **same spot** near Trento train station.





HOW TO GET TO TRENTO

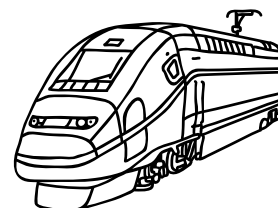
BY PLANE

Trento doesn't have its own airport. The **closest one is Verona International Airport (VRN)**, about 90 km away. It's well connected—trains run every hour, and the journey takes around one hour. Please, do make sure that there is a bus or a train connection that matches your flight. You can also consider flying into **Milan (Bergamo or Malpensa), Bologna, or Venice Treviso**. We especially recommend Bergamo (BGY) because it has a good FlixBus connection to Trento.

For Italian participants, we will cover travel costs only if they use the train or bus

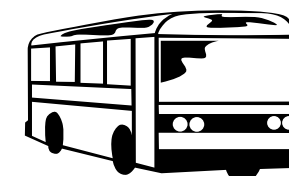
TRAIN AND BUS CONNECTION

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND FOR THE TRIP

SEND YOUR PLAN BEFORE PURCHASING AND WAIT FOR APPROVAL

Please consult our team before booking any travel. We will assist you in identifying the most suitable travel options and will check the eligibility of the tickets to ensure there are no reimbursement issues. **All tickets must be approved by us in advance, otherwise they will not be reimbursed.**

IF YOU WANT TO EXTEND YOUR TRIP

In case of earlier arrival or later departure, participants themselves **must cover the accommodation and other expenses.** Transport reimbursement covers a maximum of **either:**

- **two days before** the project starts
- **two days after** it ends
- or **one day before and one day after**

KEEP YOUR RECEIPTS

The refund will be made after receiving the complete travel documents: **keep all receipts from your trip, save the QR codes** of your flight tickets before departing taking a screenshot.

IF YOU WANT TO TRAVEL GREEN

If you want to travel green — and we encourage you to do so — write to us and together **we'll explore the possible solutions within our budget**

REIMBURSEMENT

01

Accommodation, meals and travel costs are fully covered for all participants during the period mentioned.

02

100 % of the travel costs, but no more than the maximum compensation amounts given below, will be **reimbursed** upon presenting all necessary tickets & invoices. The limit for the **travel budget varies for each country**.

03

Use this website (<https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/resources-and-tools/distance-calculator>) to **find out your distance**. Write at the START, your location, from where you will start your travel and at the END, Trento. You will get a km number as a **result which will correspond to financial support** that you may get for your travel costs. Below you will find an **approximation**:

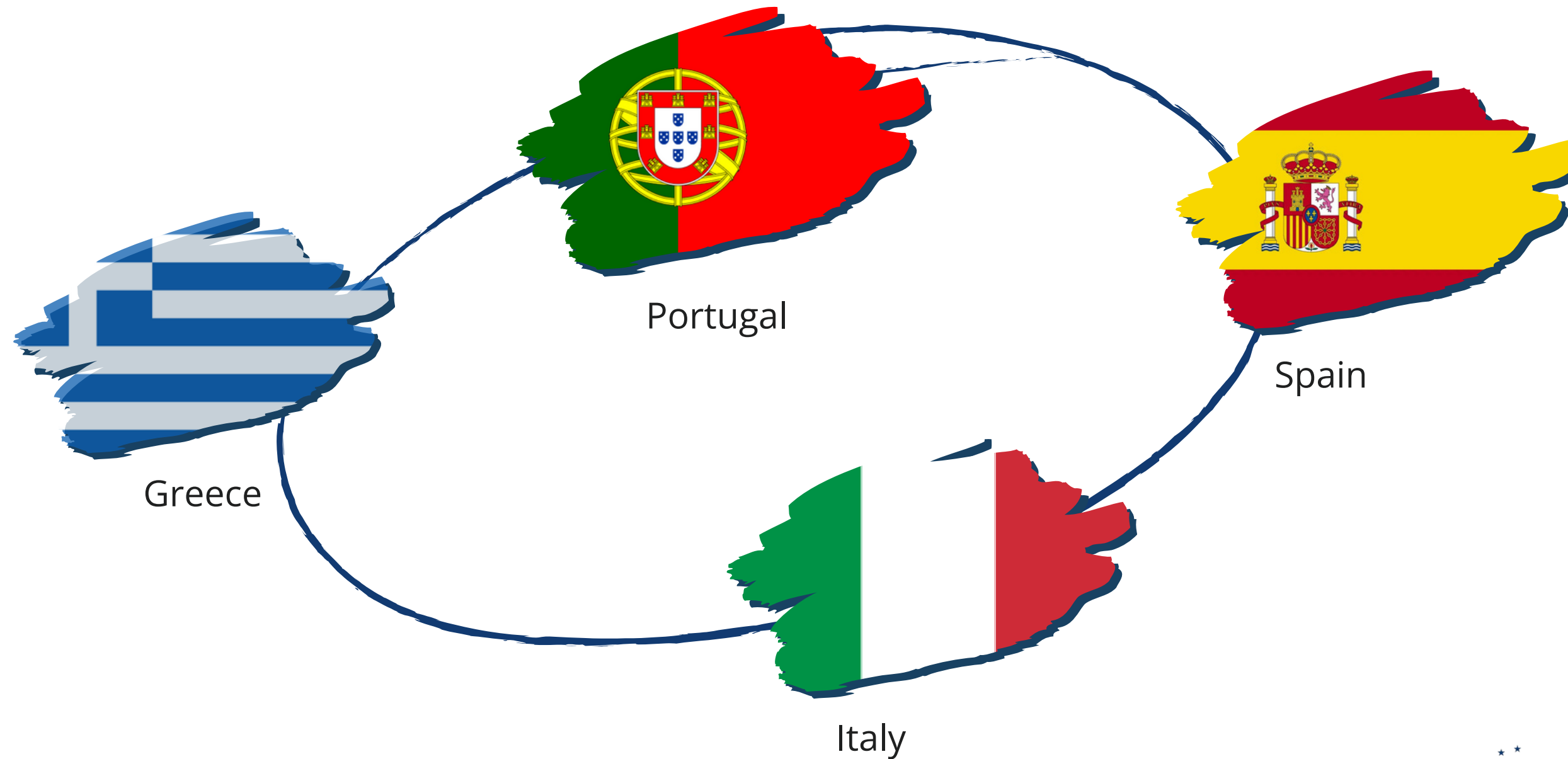
PARTICIPANTS' PROFILE

You should apply if:

- 01 you are **between 18 and 30 years old as a young participant, over 18 years old as a team leader** - an adult who supports and accompanies the national group. They ensure participants' well-being, facilitate learning, and assist communication. Team leaders coordinate with organizers and other leaders. Youth work experience and English skills are usually required.
- 02 you are from one of these countries: Portugal, Spain, Italy and Greece
- 03 our ideal candidates are passionate about addressing the topics in this info pack and are committed to creating positive change locally

Each team includes **5 young participants** aged 18 to 30, plus a **team leader** who must be over 18.

- **necessary documents**, such as IDs, EU health insurance, travel documents...
- **comfortable clothes and shoes**
- **personal care products**, such as shower gel, shampoo, comb, etc.
- **any medication** you will need during your stay
