INTRODUCTION

"Stay Clean! Stay Free!" is a youth exchange program that helps young people learn about the risks of drug use and how to live healthy, drug-free lives. Through workshops, discussions, and creative activities, you will explore ways to prevent drug addiction, support your friends, and raise awareness in your community. The program also brings together young people from different countries, giving you the chance to share ideas and make new friends. By joining, you'll become a stronger youth advocate and help spread the message: staying clean means staying free.

What are the goals?

- To increase participants' knowledge about drug prevention, peer support, and awareness-raising.
- To understand how drug use affects young people's health and social life.
- To promote teamwork and cultural exchange through international learning activities.
- To support youth-led actions that promote healthy, drug-free lifestyles.
- To help participants share what they learn with their peers and communities.
- To build a sense of European unity in the fight against drug abuse.

Financial Aspects:Restrictions and Conditions

- There is no participation fee.
- All international tickets must be approved by the hosting organisation (No Druggings Youth Project) before purchasing them.
- Tickets bought without approval will not be reimbursed.
- No taxis, no private cars, no private shuttles, or any personal means of transportation will NOT be reimbursed!
- You can only use public transportation.
- Participants must bring all relevant financial documents, such as invoices, electronic tickets, and boarding passes, to ensure reimbursement of all travel costs.

Participant's Profile

- Youngs between 18–26 (Group leader has no age limit).
- Be motivated to raise awareness about drug addiction prevention and promote healthy lifestyles;
- Be open to non-formal learning, intercultural exchange, and creative teamwork;
- Have a strong interest in working with peers, especially those from marginalized backgrounds;
 - Be willing to step out of their comfort zone and participate actively throughout the program;
 - Be available for the full exchange dates.

We especially welcome applications from individuals with fewer opportunities who want to become local changemakers in their communities.

Applications submitted on behalf of others or as group submissions will also not be accepted.

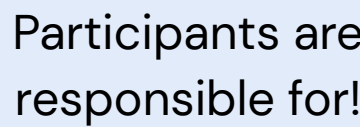

Reimbursement Procedures

- Find the cheapest travel option to Gaziantep.
- Get approval from the Hosting Organisation in Turkey.
- Buy your tickets before 1st of september 2025.
- Send your invoice and electronic tickets to the hosting organisation.
- Provide all documents in the original on the spot during the training.
- Get your reimbursement in cash on the spot.

Proper Documentations

In order for payments to be processed quickly, accurately, and without any issues, the suitability of your travel documents is crucial. Reviewing documents that do not meet the following criteria may take time, resulting in delays in payments and the need for bank transfers. Any transfer fees associated with bank transfers will be borne by the participant.

- document should contain the following information:
- 1.Passenger's Name (As it is written in passport)
 - 2.Route Invoice or ticket date
 - 3.Ticket details
 - 4.Amount (preferably in Euros)

- The following documents will not be accepted:
- 1 Bank or credit card statements

1. Bank or credit card statements
2. Monthly, weekly, or daily public transportation tickets
3. Taxi receipts
4. Documents related to travel outside the accepted route
5. Documents related to travel not approved by the organizing institution

- Participants should prepare the following documents:
- 1.Passport
 - 2.Boarding pass
 - 3.Tickets
 - 4.Entry stamp to the country (for those using a travel document other than a passport) Please ensure that your travel documents

- 4.Entry stamp to the country (for those using a travel document other than a passport) Please ensure that your travel documents meet the specified criteria to avoid any delays in payment processing

If the participant requests payment for the return journey tickets to be made after the activities at the venue (e.g airport transfer fee for return), the full payment for the travel expenses will be made to the participant via bank transfer **ONLY AFTER** the necessary documents have been submitted to the organizing institution in the appropriate manner.

Any expenses related to this transfer will be borne by the participant.
