INTRODUCTION

"Stay Clean! Stay Free!" is a youth exchange program that helps young people learn about the risks of drug use and how to live healthy, drug-free lives. Through workshops, discussions, and creative activities, you will explore ways to prevent drug addiction, support your friends, and raise awareness in your community. The program also brings together young people from different countries, giving you the chance to share ideas and make new friends. By joining, you'll become a stronger youth advocate and help spread the message: staying clean means staying free.

What are the goals?

- To increase participants' knowledge about drug prevention, peer support, and awareness-raising.
- To understand how drug use affects young people's health and social life.
- To promote teamwork and cultural exchange through international learning activities.
- To support youth-led actions that promote healthy, drug-free lifestyles.
- To help participants share what they learn with their peers and communities.
- To build a sense of European unity in the fight against drug abuse.

This innovative youth exchange empowers young people and youth workers to raise drug addiction awareness and promote social cohesion within European youth work.

Try to show your culture through customs, dances, and more—not just food and drinks.


Remember: alcohol is not allowed, as it goes against our project's mission and the event is held in a youth centre. Alcohol-free drinks are welcome.

Financial Aspects: Restrictions and Conditions

There is no participation fee.

All international tickets must be approved by the hosting organisation (No Druggings Youth Project) before purchasing them.

Tickets bought without approval will not be reimbursed.

No taxis, no private cars, no private shuttles, or any personal means of transportation will NOT be reimbursed!

You can only use public transportation.

Participants must bring all relevant financial documents, such as invoices, electronic tickets, and boarding passes, to ensure reimbursement of all travel costs.

Participant's Profile

Youngs between 18–26 (Group leader has no age limit).

Be motivated to raise awareness about drug addiction prevention and promote healthy lifestyles;

- Be open to non-formal learning, intercultural exchange, and creative teamwork;

- Have a strong interest in working with peers, especially those from marginalized backgrounds;

- Be willing to step out of their comfort zone and participate actively throughout the program;

- Be available for the full exchange dates.


We especially welcome applications from individuals with fewer opportunities who want to become local changemakers in their communities.
